The Epiphany of the Lord/B 7th January 2024

Gospel Reading Matthew 2:1-12

The visit of the Magi occurs directly before the story of the Holy Family's flight into Egypt. Matthew's Gospel tells a version of Jesus' birth that is different than the one in Luke. Of the actual birth of Jesus, Matthew tells us little more than, "When Jesus was



born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod . . . " The story of the census is found only in Luke's Gospel, but we hear about the visit of the Magi only in Matthew's Gospel.

We know little about the Magi. They come from the East and journey to Bethlehem, following an astrological sign, so we believe them to be astrologers. We assume that there were three Magi based upon the naming of their three gifts. The Gospel does not say how many Magi paid homage to Jesus. In Matthew's Gospel, they represent the Gentiles' search for a saviour. Because the Magi represent the entire world, they also represent our search for Jesus.

We have come to consider the gifts they bring as a foreshadowing of Jesus' role in salvation. We believe the meaning of the gifts to be Christological. Gold is presented as representative of Jesus' kingship. Frankincense is a symbol of his divinity because priests burned the substance in the Temple. Myrrh, which was used to prepare the dead for burial, is offered in anticipation of Jesus' death.

The word Epiphany means "manifestation" or "showing forth." Historically several moments in Christ's early life and ministry have been celebrated as "epiphanies," including his birth in Bethlehem, the visit of the Magi, his baptism by John, and his first miracle at Cana.

There will be **an hour Adoration & Benediction** on Thursdays in the month of January and regular time will resume from the 1st of February. For the month of January, the Parish office will only be open on Mondays & Fridays.

Thank you to Mary Attard & family for donating flowers this weekend.

Themes for the Feast of the Epiphany

The Feast of the Epiphany, also known as The Feast of Manifestation, is traditionally celebrated the 12th day



after Christmas, January 6th.

However, the Church celebrates this feast on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8. This year we will be celebrating Epiphany on 7 January 2023.

The feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord commemorates when Jesus Christ was revealed as the Messiah. The Gospel of Matthew recounts that three wise men from the East visited our saviour after his birth and acknowledged him with gifts representing kingship, priesthood, and death. The readings for this feast tell of the revelation of Jesus Christ to all people. The first reading tells of a light in Jerusalem which all nations are drawn to. The psalm foretells kings bringing gifts. The second reading explains how God's grace is now known to all generations and the whole world. The gospel recalls how the Magi came from afar to worship the child Jesus. It also recounts Herod's jealousy and treachery.

Blessing of the Home on Epiphany

On this day, families are invited to bless their homes and place the inscription of the year and the initials of the three Magi above each door (20+C+M+B+24). This is a way for families to remember that every time they pass through that door, they are to search for Christ and pay him homage as the wise men did. This blessing can be performed by the father or head of the family. Copies of the blessing which has been adapted from the book, "The Twelve Days of Christmas", by Elsa Chaney, can be found on the table in the Church Foyer.




