



HOW TO CELEBRATE A MAY CROWNING CEREMONY AT HOME

As the month of May is dedicated to Mary, planning a May crowning ceremony at home is a great way to recognise Mary as the Queen of Heaven and Earth. It is a traditional practice in the Church to have a May crowning on May 1 (also known as May Day) but you can do it any time during the month of May. It's traditional to crown a statue of Mary with flowers of some kind. Your flowers could be real or artificial. Just measure the head circumference of your statue and make a wreath of flowers to place on her head. Left over flowers can be used during the procession.

Before beginning your crowning ceremony at home, you may want to prepare a simple prayer space on which you can place a blue cloth (Mary's colour is blue), a candle, some flowers, and the statue of Mary. You can also place a set of rosary beads or cross or any other sacred object you like.

The May crowning usually begins with a procession before the crown of flowers is placed on Mary's head. Therefore, you can all line up and sing a song (see below for hymn choices) as you walk towards the statue and place the crown on her head. Extra flowers can be placed in a vase or placed at Mary's feet.

Once you have crowned the statue of Mary, you can recite some traditional prayers such as the Hail Mary or the Hail, Holy Queen. You can even continue to pray a decade of the Rosary or pray the entire rosary. It is really up to you.
